Baris contacted the FAES about their rooms in Building 10, “at NIH campus Bethesda, and you can call the following numbers to arrange booking / availability. These classrooms are very spacious and nice, good for basic training.” A good option – availability after hours/security?

### **Other business:**

- Fleet Captain, Dennis: boat sponsors, do we need more?
- Merchandise, Charlene: t-shirts for 2023 season -- retro from previous seasons? How about a "Flea Market" at the Crab Feast or Basic Training graduation party where members can bring "gently used" t-shirts from previous seasons to sell to new (or old!) members?
- Cruising Chairs Ruth and Peter VG: cruising planning has begun. Time for a big boat experience weekend to be determined.
- Membership Chair and BT chairs: Membership and basic training registration sites are open and working -- six students and 70 members have already registered.
- Onboard instructors: We are looking for about 15 volunteers. Peter vG will go for a sail with new volunteers. Dimitrios Anastasakis might be willing to join the onboard volunteers in 2023!
